Chata Hrádek is located up the hill with a nice view of the surrounding Beskydy mountains. During the project only the participants will be accommodated in this mountain cottage.







OBJECTIVES

- to improve key competences of young people, particularly communication, language, social, IT through various workshops and other activities
- to give young people an opportunity to cooperate on media literacy tasks
- to develop organisational skills of young people and their ability to present results of their work
- to increase awareness of young people about fake news and manipulation of people in our society
- to improve creative competences of the participants
- to improve IT competences of participants in communication with other participants of the project, in creating promotion of the project and in organisation of dissemination activities
- to strengthen international cooperation within V4
- to give young people an opportunity to learn more about other cultures and situation in partner countries



ACTIVITIES

DISCUSSION WORKSHOPS

Our main activities will be connected with media literady, to discuss the situation in media in partner countries, the role of social networks, to discuss how news are presented, why fake news appear and how people can be manipulated by media.

NATIONAL EVENINGS

Each team will organize a national evening to present their culture, history and interesting facts about the country. We are looking forward to learning more about your cultures, learn some dances, listen to your songs and watch your short films!

GAMES

In our project we will use many interesting activities, games and energizers. We will teach each other and we will learn from each other some nice traditional games and for sure we will have much fun together. Though we will spend together a short time, we will enjoy it!

TRAVEL AND FINANCES

The project is funded by the International Visegrad fund. Travel tickets will be bought by the hosting organization and the partners will use public transport to reach the venue.

Accommodation, meals, programme etc. will be covered by the organizers from the mini-grant of the "They say..." project.

CURRENCY

The currency in the Czech Republic is Czech crown (100 CZK is about 4,2 EUR). Please bring Czech crowns to the venue as it is not possible to exchange your currency to Czech crowns at the venue and there is no ATM nearby (we will be in the mountains). We recommend you to change your money for Czech crowns in your country before you arrive.

All costs regarding the project (accommodation, food) will be covered from the mini-grant of the project. You will need to cover your personal expenses.







THINGS TO BRING WITH YOU

Please, bring with you:

- information materials (leaflets, photos, stickers, posters, etc.) about your organization or group to share with other participants. Please, bring also some digital presentations of your organisation (cd, dvd, powerpoint presentation etc.)

- presentations about media and fake news in your countries / towns etc.
 - prepare some energizers and games to play together
- food and drinks, national flag and anything else for presentation of your country during the "Evenings of National culture"



FOOD AND DRINKS

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served as a choice of meals. If you have any food intolerances, please let us know in advance so that we could inform the cooks in the venue. For breaks between activities we will always prepare some refreshments (tea, coffee, cookies...) for you.

There is also a bar in the venue where you can buy some refreshment, sweets, coffee, tea and other drinks. As the project is intended for minors and most participants will be aged 15-17, drinking alcohol during the project is not allowed.
